SUBJECT: Ultra Low Sulfur Diesel (ULSD)

DATE: May 15, 2006

The Environmental Protection Agency has approved shorter language for your shipping papers or “Product Transfer Documents” (PTD’s). Our national association, PMAA, sought and received this approval. The new shortened document language is below:

For Undyed 15ppm Ultra Low Sulfur Diesel your document can read
“15ppm sulfur ULSD”

For Dyed 15ppm Ultra Low Sulfur Diesel your document can read
“15ppm sulfur Dyed ULSD, Non-road or tax exempt use only”

For Undyed 500ppm Sulfur Diesel fuel
“500ppm sulfur LSD, Not for use in 2007 or newer vehicles or engines”

For Dyed 500ppm Sulfur Diesel Fuel
“500ppm sulfur Dyed LSD, Non road or tax exempt use only,
not for use in 2007 or later vehicles”

In addition to this language your PTD should also include

- 1) The name and address of the transferor and transferee.
- 2) The volume of diesel fuel or distillate being transferred.
- 3) The location of the diesel fuel or distillate at the time of transfer.
- 4) The date of the transfer.

These guidelines go into effect June 1, 2006.
